City Receives \$3 Million Grant

In December 2012, the California Water Resources Control Board notified the City of Modesto that the Storm Drain Cross Connection Removal – Garrison Park Project was selected for a \$3 million grant.

Portions of the City of Modesto's storm water flows are diverted into the sanitary sewer system through cross connections. In most cases, a cross pipe from a surface inlet or from a rockwell directly connects to a sewer manhole. These cross connections overburden the sewer system during heavy storm events, and occasionally lead to sanitary sewer overflows (overflow or spill of untreated or partially treated sewage).

This project will improve storm water drainage in the Carver/Orangeburg area. The cross connections will be removed and several hundred feet of storm drain piping will be installed to drain storm water from an approximate 24-acre tributary area to Garrison Park, where it will be stored in underground percolation chambers. The project will also reduce local street flooding and restore portions of the irrigation, sod, and playground equipment at Garrison Park.

Construction is scheduled to begin this winter (2013) and will finish in the fall of 2014.

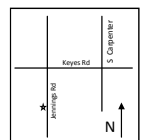
