



## TUOLUMNE RIVER REGIONAL PARK CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

### PURPOSE OF COMMITTEE

The Citizens Advisory Committee is to be a support group of interested people appointed from Stanislaus County and the Cities of Ceres and Modesto to research and develop ideas and programs for providing a flow of income to the park through the following means:

1. Through government support, grants, use policies and/or fees.
2. Developing ideas for completing the park general plan through joint ventures with private entrepreneurs and/or concessionaires.
3. Promoting the park to various business, corporations and clubs by encouraging them to participate in the actual development of the remaining portions of the master plan and the park.

**The primary role of the Tuolumne River Regional Park Citizens Advisory Committee is to act in an advisory capacity to the Tuolumne River Regional Park Commission in matters pertaining to the design, development, enhancement and use of the Park.**

**GUIDELINES**

1. MEMBERSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

- a. The Committee shall consist of ten members: five from Stanislaus County, three from the City of Modesto, and two from the City of Ceres.
- b. Members shall be appointed or removed by resolution of the County Board of Supervisors, City of Modesto City Council, or City of Ceres City Council, respectively.
- c. No member shall be a paid City or County employee.
- d. Each member must be a registered voter. In the case of County representatives, must be a registered voter in the District represented.

2. TERM OF COMMITTEE MEMBERS

- a. Members will be appointed for four-year terms.
- b. There will be no limit to the number of terms.

3. OFFICERS

- a. Officers will include:
  - 1) Chair
  - 2) Vice Chair
- b. Officers will serve a one-year term.
- c. Officers will be selected by a simple majority vote of the Tuolumne River Regional Park Citizens Advisory Committee.
- d. There will be no limit to the number of reappointments.
- e. The Nominating Committee will be appointed by the Chair no later than the regular business meeting in November.
- f. The Nominating Committee will present their recommendations to the full Committee at their regular business meeting in January.
- g. Officers will be elected at the regular business meeting in January.
- h. Newly elected officers will assume their responsibilities at the regular business meeting in February.

Guidelines, cont'd.

4. REGULAR MEETINGS OF THE COMMITTEE

- a. Regular meetings of the Committee will occur on the second Wednesday of each month. Meetings shall be held at 12:15 p.m. at a location designated by the Chair.
- b. Special meetings may be called by the Chair or Vice Chair as necessary, with the date, time and location to be determined by the Chair.
- c. A quorum shall consist of a simple majority of the appointed members of the Committee.

5. ATTENDANCE

- a. If a member is absent from three (3) consecutive regular business meetings, the Chairperson may recommend to the Tuolumne River Regional Park Citizens Advisory Committee to request removal and replacement of the member.
- b. The Chairperson may excuse members from regular meetings. Excused absences will be noted in the minutes at a regular meeting.
