### **Tully Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project (Yale Avenue to Briggsmore Avenue)**

#### **Project Description:**

Pavement rehabilitation project on Tully Road from Yale Avenue to Briggsmore Avenue. The length of the project is 1.1 mile. Anticipated project improvements include roadway resurfacing, new signage and striping, ADA upgrades, vehicle detection cameras at Roseburg Avenue, Orangeburg Avenue, Granger Avenue and Briggsmore Avenue, and storm drainage system improvements.

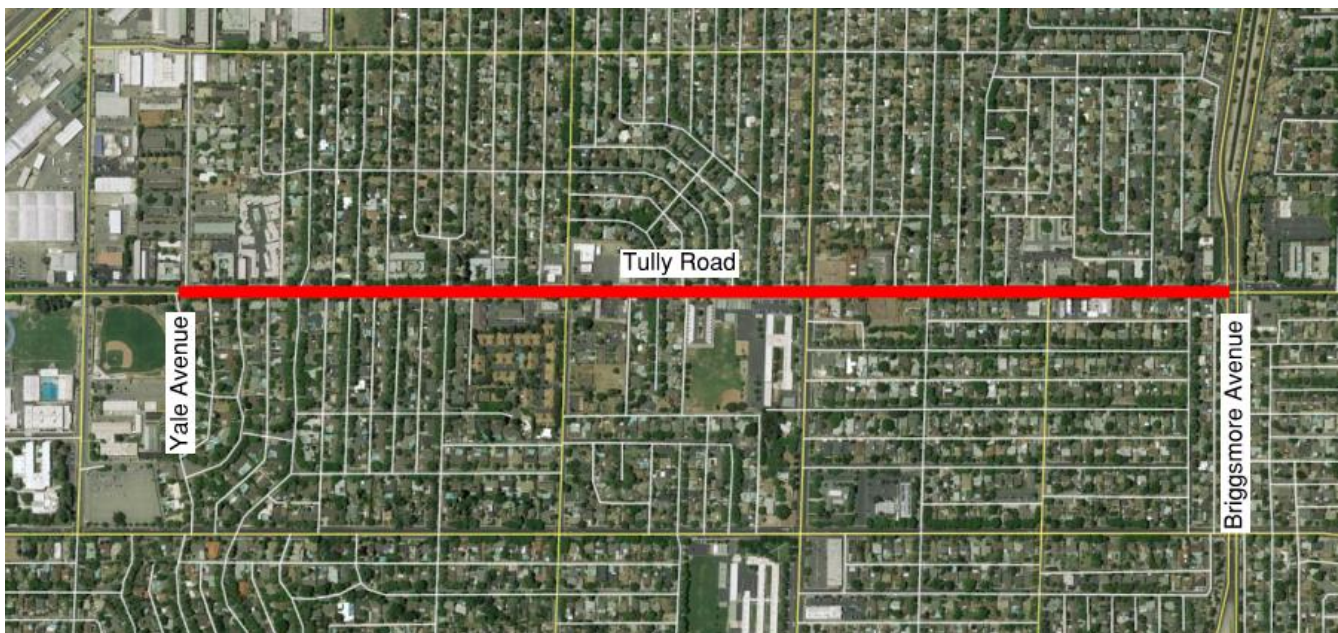
